Journey along Alabama's highways to explore the road to freedom. This three-day, immersive experience will allow educators to traverse east and west of the Capital City, from Tuskegee to Montgomery to Selma, to gain insight into both the *struggle* and the *hope* toward the full freedom of American citizenship. Teacher-travelers will gain valuable insight into transforming their local communities into laboratories of learning and come away with ideas to enhance instruction and student achievement through innovative strategies to weave into their existing practice. Our workshop's road map includes valuable historical content, literacy strategies to support state testing, and place-based education ideas.

NOTE: This workshop will take place in a different city each day (Tuskegee, Montgomery, Selma). Participants are expected to attend all three days. Transportation will be provided to the sites from Montgomery each day.
